

Unipeers Code of Conduct

All members should read the following code of conduct before signing up to the Slack workspace. If they have any questions, they should email contact@unipeers.org.

Our Code of Conduct outlines our expectations regarding Unipeers members' behavior towards each other and the community. It applies to everyone in the Unipeers community. We outline the components of our Code of Conduct below.

Respect in the Slack Workspace

All members should respect the other members. We won't allow any kind of discriminatory behavior, harassment or victimization. We promote freedom of expression and open communication, and we expect members to foster a well-organized, respectful and collaborative environment. They should avoid offending, participating in disputes and disrupting the community. The moderators reserve the right to remove any inappropriate or irrelevant messages from the chat.

Compliance with Law

We expect members to be ethical and responsible when dealing with Unipeers' products, partnerships, public image, and other aspects.

Privacy Protection

No member of Unipeers must share their personal information or that of another member with other members or externally. All members must comply with FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) regulations on student privacy. Moreover, Unipeers members must not send surveys or questionnaires to the chat, unless otherwise instructed by the moderators.

Disciplinary Actions

Unipeers may have to take disciplinary action against members who repeatedly or intentionally fail to follow our code of conduct. Disciplinary actions will vary depending on the violation and can range from expulsion from the chat to legal action. Additionally, Unipeers has the right to remove any member from the workspace at any time if deemed necessary.
